Seymour Ginsburg, 87, of Vi at Lakeside Village in Lantana and formerly of Ponte Vecchio in Boynton Beach passed away Wednesday November 30, 2016. Seymour was born in Elizabeth, New Jersey and raised in Trenton. A retired teacher, he was the president and chief negotiator of the teacher's union in Long Island before retiring to Florida. He was also a proud Air Force veteran.
