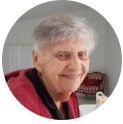

**H**annah 'Ann' Ferber Worstadt, born November 12, 1922 in Brooklyn, New York, passed away on March 26th, 2020 at the age of 97 in Boynton Beach, Florida. She was a devoted wife to the love of her life, the late Sidney Worstadt (who passed in 2011). While Sidney was serving overseas in the Army during WWII, she became a real-life 'Rosie the Riveter', working long days setting magneto points for war plane engines.
