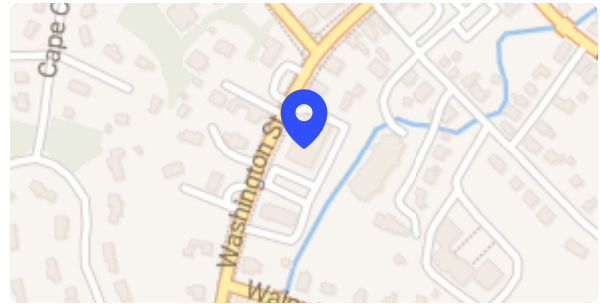

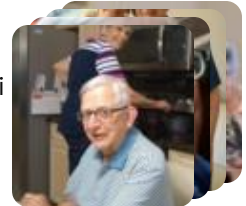
This is how we will remember Bob: always smiling. He loved life, he loved those around him, and always had a cute joke to share. A very special friend, close to our heart. Barry and Betty
