Survivors are her loving children, Aaron Jade (Enid Barden), son, and Rebecca Jade Tinter (Alan Tinter), daughter of Fort Lauderdale, FL. 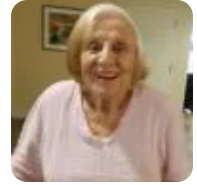
