And, after retirement, she volunteered in the Boynton Beach area as a Patient Liaison in hospitals and nursing homes. She also assisted teachers in the classroom with autistic students. And ushered at the Kravis Center.

When she wasn't volunteering, Linda spent a lot of her time with family; hosted and planned reunions, holiday feasts, and family gatherings; traveled; enjoyed sports (tennis, pickle ball, and bowling); played board games with friends (mahjong and canasta); and read fiction.
