**L**ynne Jill Miller, 75, passed away on Wednesday, October 11, 2023.

Born to Hilda and Ely Wallenstein on October 26, 1947, Lynne grew up in Bayside, New York. She embarked upon a career in education following her graduation from Queens College, spending more than 25 years as an educator with the Farmingdale (N.Y.) School District.

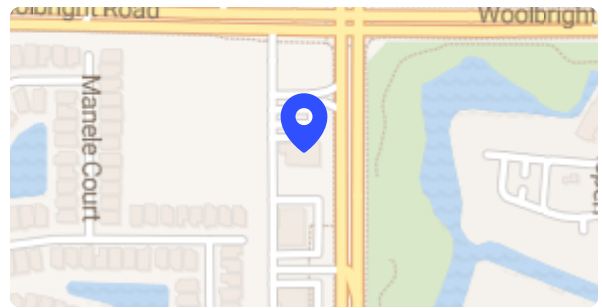
