Shiva will be held at her home immediately after the funeral on Tuesday 11/21 and Wednesday 11/22 and Friday 11/24

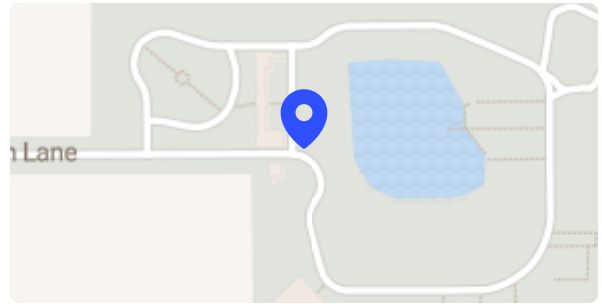

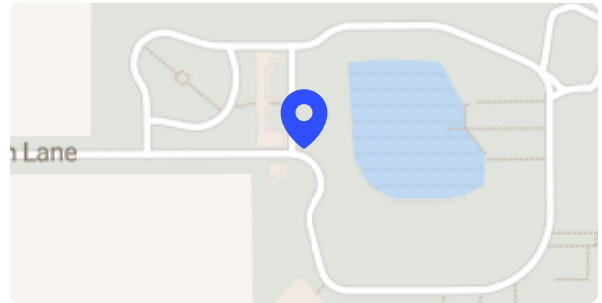
