Chester “Chet” Franklin Lipner, 81, of Lake Worth, Florida passed away Monday, December 4, 2023 at his home.

Chet was born October 8, 1942 in Washington D.C. to Alice and Leon Lipner. He moved to Queens, NY when he was 13 years old.
