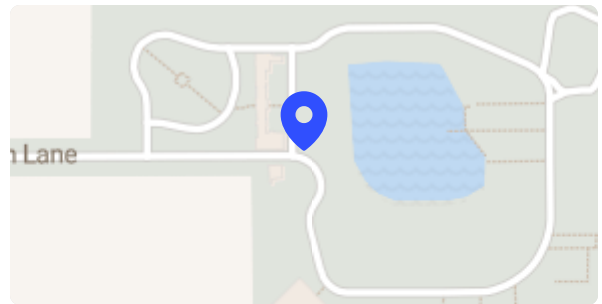

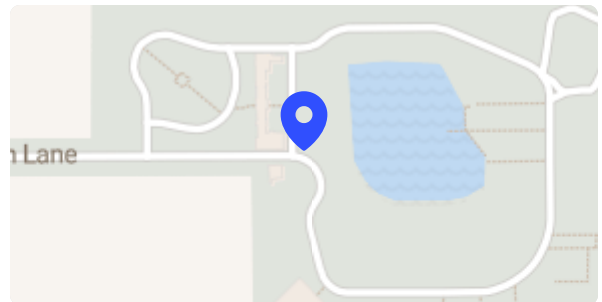

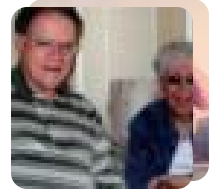
David Verch posted:
