# Karen D'Anne Means

**K**aren D'Anne Means was 64 years old when she passed away on April 30, 2024 in Boynton Beach, Florida after a long-fought battle with cancer.

Preceding D'Anne in death were her father, Dale Paul and her first daughter, Paige Means. Her legacy will continue on through her mother, JoAnne Paul; her husband, David Means; her children, Chase Means, Victoria Tramonte, Seth Means, Allison Oliver, and Peyton Loffelmacher; and her grandchildren, Olivia Means, Adeline Tramonte and Pierce Tramonte.

others and loved hosting and would love for us all to have a bit of a party.

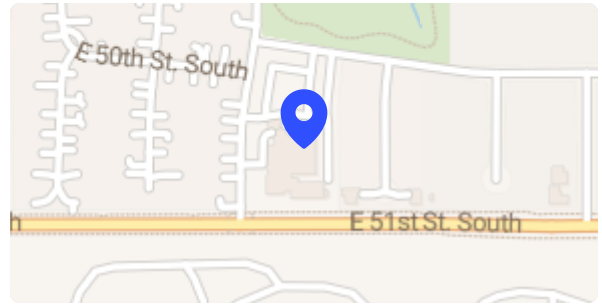
