CAROLYN F. CUKIER, a native of Brooklyn, NY and former Boynton Beach, FL resident, who more recently lived at Sunrise Senior Living in Cohasset, passed away on Thursday, June 13th at 89 years of age. Carolyn, daughter of Jack & Sylvia (Kaplan) Max, was a devoted sister to younger brother Stephen, whose Down's Syndrome defined her indefatigable, charity work with the Association for the Help of Retarded Children (now known as AHRC). It could be said that Carolyn was quite a character, whose humor, spirit and smile lit up a room. She adored music, live performance and danced in many community productions.
