A Graveside service will be held on Tuesday, March 11, 2025 at Eternal Light Memorial Gardens at 1:30 pm.

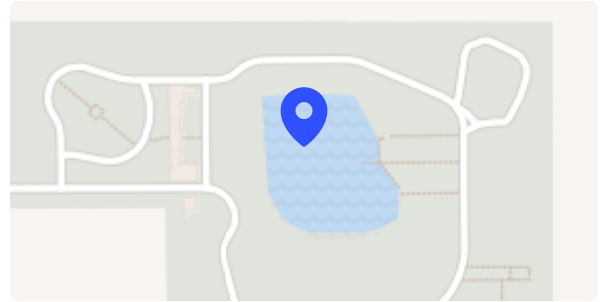
