Gordon will be remembered for his gentle nature, his steady presence, and the love he gave so freely. He will be deeply missed and forever loved.

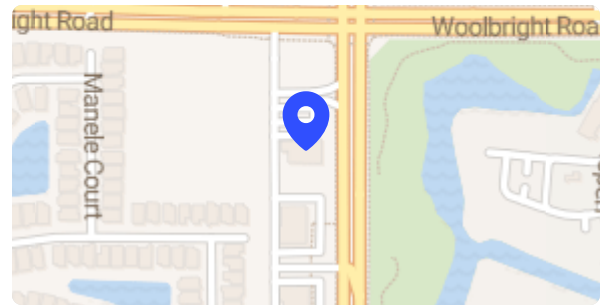
